## Volunteer Role Outline

**Volunteer Role:** Outcomes Champion

**Responsible to:** Sally McVicker

**Time requirement:** At least 1 hour per week when groups running

**Location:** SE1, EC1, BR1 – various according to group

- To subscribe to the ethos, values, mission and vision of Aphasia Re-Connect.
- To actively oversee and monitor the collection of outcome data across all Aphasia Re-Connect's groups.
- To sign up interested and committed volunteers to work alongside you as group reps for the collection of outcomes data.

### Tasks

- To contribute to the collection of outcome data for Aphasia Re-Connect.
- To engage and facilitate outcome reps for each group following the protocol of liaison guided by good communication access with people with aphasia
- To build a reliable spreadsheet to oversee data collection, via source and when due (date) and completed (date), across all groups.
- To provide prompts to group reps when outcome data collection is due.
- To keep in regular contact with Sally.
- To contribute to Advisory Group meetings with Sally at least once every six months.
- To follow and adhere to user consent and confidentiality guidelines as set out in law

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## **Support/training provided by Aphasia Re-Connect**

- Communication access training and training to use the Aphasia Impact Questionnaire
- Regular supervision and support.
