Time requirement: At least 1 hour per month when groups running

Location: SE1, EC1, BR1 – various according to group

- To subscribe to the ethos, values, mission and vision of Aphasia Re-Connect.
- To actively collect outcome data within the Aphasia Re-Connect group that you attend or could willingly visit.
- To keep the Outcomes Champion updated

Tasks

- To contribute to the collection of outcome data for Aphasia Re-Connect within the group setting that you volunteer within, or a setting of your choosing.
- To liaise directly with the people with aphasia to book the time and place for the outcome collection, and confirm with them in accessible written format.
- To keep in regular contact with the Outcomes Champion.
- To feed ideas into the Advisory Group meetings once every six months via liaison with the Outcomes Champion / Sally.
- To follow and adhere to user consent and confidentiality guidelines as set out in law
