What is Aphasia?

Every 5 minutes somebody has a stroke. One in 3 will have Aphasia.

Aphasia affects more than 350,000 people in the UK "I know what I want to say. I just can't find the words."

Aphasia is most commonly caused by stroke, but can be caused by head injury or brain tumour

Aphasia can affect speaking, reading, writing and sometimes understanding. It does not affect intelligence.
